Tucked away in the sleepy harbour town of Watchet this designer B&B is big on style. Previously an 18th century shop, its owners (former Disney execs) have restored it in shades of white, dove and slate grey, with treats like roll-top baths, cast-iron radiators, and huge murals based on National Gallery paintings. Flop on to the sofa in front of the fire after walks along the coastal path from the harbour to Blue Anchor Bay.
