ART HOUSE CHIC Swain House, Watchet, Somerset

Watchet is an ancient harbour town in Somerset that's a bit of find. It's unspoiled and perched on the coast with Exmoor behind it. On the well-preserved Victorian High Street is Swain House, a B&B housed in what used to be a couple of village shops. Step through the front door and enter a stylish, sophisticated pad that's decorated in shades of muted grey. Bedrooms are decorated in Farrow & Ball neutrals with the eye-catching feature wall consisting of a mural of a painting from the National Gallery or the National Portrait Gallery. The ensuite has a slipper bath, double walk-in shower, fluffy bathrobes and REN toiletries. If you're up for extra indulgence, luxuries such as homemade truffles or a bottle of champagne on ice can be ordered. While you're there: as Watchet is deep in the heart of cider country, it would be rude not to check out the local brew at Torre Cider Farm (torrecider.com). If you're feeling adventurous, have a go at coasteering —travelling along the base of sea cliffs (activeadventuresw.co.uk).
